

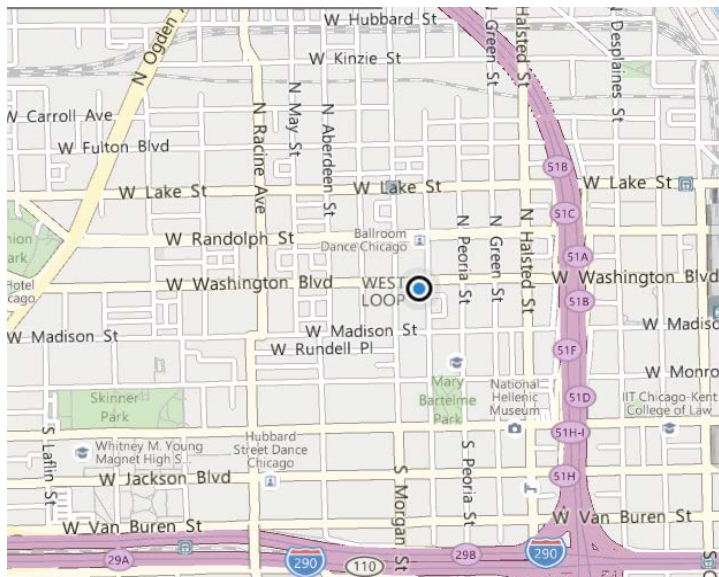

D.U.I. RISK EDUCATION

The goal of the DUI Risk Education Program is to assist participants in understanding the effects of alcohol/drugs on human lives and to help them to avoid another DUI arrest.

The purpose of the DUI Risk Education Program is to provide orientation to offenders regarding the impact of alcohol and other drug use on individual behavior and driving skills and to allow offenders to further explore the personal ramifications of their own substance use and abuse.

Ten Hours of Risk Education Includes:

- The Current DUI Laws
- Alcohol and Other Drugs/Effects on the Body and Brain
- Chemical Dependency
 - Progression
 - Recovery
 - Family Issues
 - Stress
 - Alternatives

Fees:

<u>Minimal Risk:</u>	10 hours of Risk Education	\$200
<u>Moderate Risk:</u>	10 hours of Risk Education and 12 hours of Early Intervention	\$500
<u>Significant Risk:</u>	10 hours of Risk Education 20 hours Substance Abuse Treatment Up to 6 months of Continuing Care	\$650
<u>High Risk:</u>	10 hours of Risk Education 75 hours Substance Abuse Treatment Up to 6 months of Continuing Care	\$2000
