Priority Admission Policy

Haymarket Center adheres to requirements set forth by the Code of Federal Regulations pertaining to the Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Block Grant. As such, Haymarket Center will give preference in admissions as follows:

- (1) Pregnant injecting drug users
- (2) Pregnant substance abusers
- (3) Injecting drug users
- (4) All others

In addition, as required by the Illinois Division of Alcoholism and Substance abuse, Haymarket Center will give preference in admission among "all others" to:

- Postpartum women
- Known HIV infected persons
- Service Members, Veterans and their families (SMVF)
- Parenting substance users
- Illinois Department of Children and Family Services referral; Persons eligible for Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) and other women and children; Department of Corrections (DOC); releases who have completed a prison treatment program; Clients of a DASA "designated program" for DOC released individuals.
